Project P.R.I.D.E is a program at Green Local Schools coming together of parents, Green High School Service Learning Students and college volunteers to support the reading achievement of Ohio's students reading below grade level. Project P.R.I.D.E uses an evidence-based model of 1:1 reading mentoring for students reading below grade level, including students with disabilities. K-3 Students are mentored 4 times per week by trained mentors using individualized lesson plans.

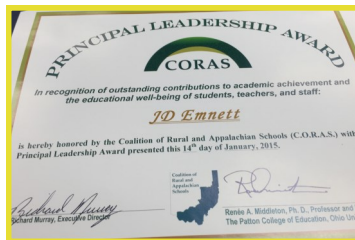
